



Dick Boushey is arguably one of the most attentive and focused growers in Washington State. 2007 represented the second year that we worked with these three syrah clones and we're amazed and what we're seeing. 2007 gave us a slightly cooler vintage and the resulting wine reflects just this: focus, elegance and balance. Blended in similar percentages to our 2006 wine, we're still getting that signature Boushey earthiness and captivating aromatic profile. The three clones planted here are so different from one another and it's been a real education watching them mature in barrel. The 174 clone is the most complete, while the TC brings a wonderful silkiness to the palate; the 877 offers a meaty, gamey side to the blend.

AROMATICS

Smokey and spicy with hints of black pepper, bacon and blueberry.

PALATE

Silky and spicy with excellent balance, good acidity and sleek blue and black fruits on the finish.
