It is arguable one of the greatest white grape sites in Washington with its cool climate, wonderfully mineral rich soil and high winds that move the 50" of annual rainfall off the canopy.

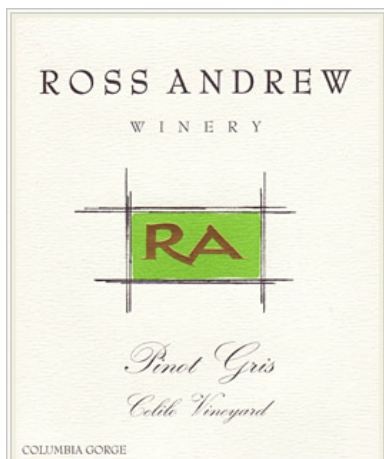
This is pure Spring and Summer in a glass.
